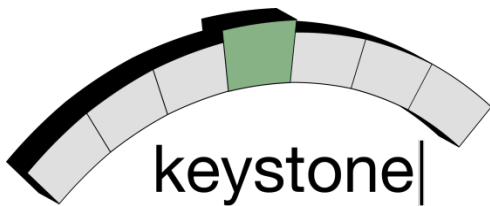
- ▶ **IMPORTANT:** we need to have the budget in the e-cost in 1 week (1 March)
